

1	12 March 2025	Druzhba Hotel, Kryvyi Rih	At approximately 07:15, a missile struck the Druzhba Hotel in Kryvyi Rih. At around 07:39, shortly after first responders arrived at the scene and had begun rescue operations, a second missile hit the same area. Notably, this was not the first attack on the Druzhba Hotel; an earlier strike occurred in October 2024. One person was killed and 14 injured.	1 dead, 14 injured	9M723
2	5 March 2025	Tsentralnyi Hotel, Kryvyi Rih	At approximately 22:00, a Russian missile struck the roof of the Tsentralnyi Hotel in Kryvyi Rih, in the second attack on the hotel. Among those affected were humanitarian workers who were staying in the hotel at the time of the strike. Six people were killed and 31 were injured.	6 dead, 31 injured	9M723
3	22 February 2025	Park House Hotel, Kryvyi Rih	At approximately 22:25, two Russian 9M723 ballistic missiles struck the area surrounding the Park House Hotel in Kryvyi Rih. One person was killed and five injured.	1 dead, 5 injured	9M723
4	31 January 2025	Bristol Hotel, Odesa	At approximately 19:20, Russian forces conducted a missile strike that targeted the Bristol Hotel in the centre of Odesa. The strike also caused damage to several nearby historic buildings. The attack injured seven people, including one hotel employee.	7 injured	9M723
5	19 October 2024	Tsentralnyi Hotel, Kryvyi Rih	At approximately 23:00, a Russian missile struck the area adjacent to the Tsentralnyi Hotel in Kryvyi Rih. The blast caused damage to nearby residential buildings and the local Palace of Culture, which was actively functioning at the time, hosting performances and events for the community. At least four civilians were injured in the attack.	4 injured	9M723
6	19 October 2024	Druzhba Hotel, Kryvyi Rih	At 22:42, a Russian 9M723 ballistic missile struck the	17 injured	9M723

			Druzhba Hotel in Kryvyi Rih, hitting the building's outer wall and destroying sections of the first and second floors. At around 23:11, a second missile targeted the same area, likely detonating in the air above the hotel in what appears to be a double-tap strike. In total, 17 people were injured, including one police officer and one firefighter responding to the initial strike.		
7	2 October 2024	Kamelot Hotel, Sloviansk	At approximately 04:55, Russian forces struck the premises of the Kamelot Hotel in Sloviansk, causing extensive damage to the hotel building. One person was injured in the strike.	1 injured	Unknown
8	20 September 2024	Palace Hotel, Kharkiv	At approximately 23:00, a Russian aerial bomb hit the road in the centre of Kharkiv, between the Kharkiv Palace Hotel and a medical facility. This was the second time the hotel was attacked. The hotel building was damaged, but there were no reported casualties.	No reported casualties	FAB-250
9	7 September 2024	Zorya Hotel, Mykolaivka	At approximately 21:50, four aerial bombs struck the building of the Zorya Hotel in Mykolaivka. According to a statement from the Ukrainian police, five people were inside the hotel at the time of the strike. Three of them, who were on the first floor, survived, likely due to their location. Two volunteers from the Kharkiv volunteer organization ZooControl were killed.	2 dead	Aerial bomb
10	4 September 2024	Arena Hotel, Kryvyi Rih	At approximately 06:00, a Russian missile struck the three-story Arena Hotel in Kryvyi Rih. The hotel, owned by a state-operated circus located near the premises, had ceased operations after the full-scale invasion started. 11	2 September 2024	Grand Palace Hotel,	At approximately 23:00, a ballistic missile struck the	2 dead, 2 injured	Ballistic missile (type unknown)

		Zaporizhzhia	Grand Palace Hotel in Zaporizhzhia. According to the hotel's owner, interviewed by TH, no guests were staying in the hotel at the time of the attack. However, two members of the family that owned the hotel—a mother and her eight-year-old son—were killed, and a further two—the father and twelve-year-old daughter—were injured.		
12	31 August 2024	Druzhba Hotel, Pokrovsk	At approximately 03:00, the Druzhba Hotel in Pokrovsk was directly struck by a missile reportedly launched from an S-300 (S-400) system. The facility had previously sustained damage in a double-tap strike one year earlier and had not resumed operations since. There were no reported casualties. 13	28 August 2024	Ukrainochka Hotel, Kryvyi Rih	At approximately 11:00, the Ukrainochka Hotel in Kryvyi Rih was targeted with a 9M723 missile, which struck approximately 40 meters from the building. The hotel sustained minor damage from the blast, and nine people were injured as a result of the explosion.	9 injured	9M723
14	26 August 2024	Avrora Hotel, Kryvyi Rih	At 23:18, a Russian 9M723 missile struck the Avrora Hotel in Kryvyi Rih, causing severe damage to one side of the building. Several surrounding buildings also sustained damage. Four people were killed and five others injured.	4 dead, 5 injured	9M723
15	24 August 2024	Sapphire Hotel, Kramatorsk	At approximately 22:30, a 9M723 missile struck the two-storey Sapphire Hotel in Kramatorsk, where six members of a Reuters team were staying. A British citizen, Reuters security advisor Ryan Evans was killed, and five other Reuters media personnel and four civilians were injured.	1 dead, 9 injured	9M723
16	17 April 2024	Profspilkovyi Hotel, Chernihiv	At 08:59, Russian cruise missiles struck the Profspilkovyi Hotel in Chernihiv. The hotel was reportedly being used by Ukrainian military personnel as	18 dead, 78 injured	9M727 / 9M728 / 9M729

17	6 February 2024	Hotel in Zolochiv, Kharkiv oblast	At approximately 02:20, two Russian missiles launched from an S-300 (S-400) system struck the village of Zolochiv in Kharkiv Oblast. As a result, a small hotel located in the village centre was hit. The hotel had three rooms, all of which were occupied at the time. A two-month-old boy staying there with his mother was killed in the attack. The mother and two other female residents were injured.	1 dead, 3 injured	5V55 / 48N6
18	10 January 2024	Park Hotel, Kharkiv	At approximately 22:30, Russian forces targeted the Park Hotel in Kharkiv with two missiles launched from an S-300 or S-400 system. One missile struck the hotel yard, while the other hit one of the hotel buildings. It was reported that the hotel had not been used by soldiers and was primarily accommodating journalists. A journalist from the Turkish news agency <i>Anadolu</i> and a local producer working with the France 2 sustained injuries, and a further eleven people were also injured.	13 injured	5V55 / 48N6 (or their modifications)
19	30 December 2023	Palace Hotel, Kharkiv	At approximately 19:00, a 9M723 missile struck the upper floors of the Kharkiv Palace Hotel in the city centre. Several members of a ZDF media team were staying at the hotel at the time, along with a New York Times media team and other civilian guests. A Ukrainian producer and a British security adviser working with ZDF were seriously injured in the attack. The hotel was damaged again on 20 September 2024.	2 injured	9M723
20	25 September 2023	Odesa Hotel, Odesa	On the night of 24-25 September 2023, in a Russian combined air attack on Odesa, the Odesa Hotel was severely damaged and subsequently engulfed in flames. 21	10 August 2023	Reikartz Hotel, Zaporizhzhia	At approximately 19:20, two Russian cruise missiles struck the Reikartz Hotel in Zaporizhzhia. The hotel was known to be frequented by journalists, humanitarian organizations, and United Nations personnel. One elderly woman was killed and nineteen people were injured, including four children.	1 dead, 19 injured	9M727 / 9M728 / 9M729
22	7 August 2023	Druzhba Hotel, Pokrovsk	At approximately 19:15 and 19:50, two Russian cruise missiles struck Pokrovsk in a double-tap attack, first hitting a residential building near the Druzhba Hotel, then directly striking the hotel itself. The hotel had been closed shortly before the attack after the administration received a warning about a possible strike. 23	16 April 2023	Reikartz Hotel, Zaporizhzhia	In the early hours of the morning (approximately between 05:00 and 06:00), Russian missiles launched from an S-300 (S-400) system struck several locations in the city of Zaporizhzhia, including the Reikartz Hotel. The hotel sustained minor damage from the blast wave, but there were no reported casualties.	No reported casualties	5V55 / 48N6 (or their modifications)
24	31 December 2022	Alfavito Hotel, Kyiv	At approximately 14:15, a Russian missile struck the Alfavito Hotel in central Kyiv, destroying five floors in the front section of the building. According to the hotel's deputy director, most guests had already checked out at the time of the attack, in part due to the Christmas holidays. A Japanese journalist residing at the hotel was injured.	1 injured	Missile (type unknown)

26	22 September 2022	Sunrise Park Hotel, Zaporizhzhia	<p>At approximately 07:30, Russian missiles struck the Sunrise Park Hotel in Zaporizhzhia, impacting both the hotel building and its surrounding premises. Around 40 people were inside the hotel at the time of the attack. One person was killed and five were injured. The hotel was targeted again on 27 September 2022.</p>	1 dead, 5 injured	5V55 / 48N6 (or their modifications)
27	18 September 2022	Kramatorsk Hotel, Kramatorsk	<p>In the early hours of the morning (approximately between 03:00 and 04:00), a ballistic missile hit the Kramatorsk hotel in the city of Kramatorsk. The hotel was struck while only civilians were inside, including a security guard, a hotel manager, a female traveler, a volunteer, and a journalist. Notably, the hotel had a policy of not accommodating military personnel for security reasons. The strike injured the female traveller.</p>	1 injured	Ballistic missile (type unknown)
28	31 July 2022	Optima River Hotel [formerly Reikartz River Hotel], Mykolaiv	<p>On the night of 30-31 July 2022, two Russian missiles launched from an S-300 (S-400) system exploded in the premises of the Reikartz River Hotel in Mykolaiv during a large Russian air attack on the city. The hotel was restored and reopened in 2023 under the new name of 'Optima River' but was damaged again in April 2024 by a Shahed drone.</p>	Unknown	5V55 / 48N6 (or their modifications)
29	14 July 2022	Mykolaiv Hotel, Mykolaiv	<p>At around 05:00 a Russian missile hit the upper floors of the Mykolaiv Hotel in the city of Mykolaiv with missiles launched from an S-300 (S-400) system.</p>	Unknown	5V55 / 48N6 (or their modifications)
30	21 March 2022	Inhul Hotel, Mykolaiv	<p>Between 13.00 and 13.30 Russian aviation attacked the roof of the Inhul Hotel in Mykolaiv with aerial bombs. The hotel was not operating at the time, and there were no reported casualties.</p>	No reported casualties	Aerial bomb
